Resene art with Mark Rayner – 10

Brighten up any modern interior with this easy to make abstract painting.

You will need:

- 457mm x 457mm primed artist canvas
- Paintbrushes
- Resene Lumbersider tinted to Resene All Black
- Resene Multishield+ gloss
- Resene testpots in the following colours: Resene Chetwode Blue, Resene Deep Koamaru, Resene Governor Bay, Resene Jacksons Purple, Resene Paua and Resene Portage



Step one
Paint the face and edges of canvas with two coats of Resene All Black, allowing at least two hours to dry.



Step two
Using a small artist's brush, dribble Resene Paua over the centre of the painted canvas, keeping approximately 25mm from each edge.



Step three
Repeat step two using Resene Deep Koamaru.



Step four
Repeat step two using Resene Jacksons Purple.



Step five
Repeat step two using Resene Governor Bay.



Step six
Repeat step two using Resene Chetwode Blue.



Step seven
Repeat step two using Resene Portage.



Step eight
Paint the face and edges of canvas with two coats of Resene Multishield+ gloss, allowing at least two hours to dry.



To get the look:

Mark painted the surrounding wall with Resene Zylone Sheen tinted to Resene Dizzy Lizzy.



Other ideas:

For even greater contrast try using a selection of red shades from the Resene Multi-Finish Palette P05 chart on a bright green base from the Resene Multi-Finish Palette P22 chart.
