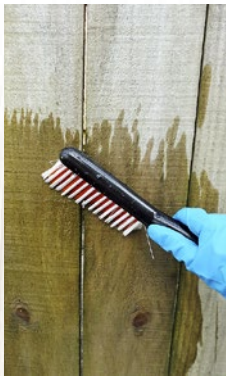
Ways with wood
with Mark Rayner – 93

You will need:

- Bucket
- Garden hose with clean running water
- Paintbrushes (one small and one large)
- Paint stirrer
- Resene Moss & Mould Killer
- Resene Timber and Deck Wash
- Resene Waterborne Woodsman tinted to Resene Warm Kwila
- Rubber gloves
- Stiff-bristled brush
- Wooden fence and trellis



Step 1
Mix one part Resene Moss & Mould Killer to five parts clean water.



Step 2
Wearing rubber gloves, saturate and scrub the solution into the fence and trellis with a stiff-bristled brush and leave for 48 hours.



Step 3
Mix one part Resene Timber and Deck Wash to three parts clean water.



Step 4
Scrub the fence and trellis thoroughly with the solution using a stiff-bristled brush.



Step 5
Rinse well with clean water and allow the fence and trellis to dry.



Step 6
Carefully stir the Resene Waterborne Woodsman tinted to Resene Warm Kwila.



Step 7
Using a small paintbrush apply one coat of Resene Waterborne Woodsman tinted to Resene Warm Kwila to the trellis and allow to dry.



Step 8
Using a large paintbrush apply one coat of Resene Waterborne Woodsman tinted to Resene Warm Kwila to the fence and allow to dry. Repeat steps seven and eight.



To get the look:
Mark planted a hedge of fresh green Griselinia to contrast with the warm red of the fence stain.



Other ideas:
For a dark brown effect, stain the fence and trellis with Resene Waterborne Woodsman tinted to Resene Dark Oak.
