Surface preparation

No special preparation necessary.

Application

Apply by stiff bristle scrubbing brush or broom. Rinse with steamcleaning or waterblasting equipment. Wear safety glasses with sideshields, protective clothing and gloves (neoprene or butyl rubber).

- 1. Apply heavily to the area to be degreased.
- 2. Allow a contact time of 5-15 minutes. Cleaning is aided by scrubbing the surface, especially if the surface is pitted.
- 3. Rinse by steamcleaning, waterblasting or by hose and scrubbing.
- 4. If oil and grease deposits remain, repeat the above procedure.
- 5. Allow degreased surface to dry thoroughly if painting.

Precautions

- This material may be harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin, and may cause skin or eye irritation.
- 2. Avoid breathing vapour use with adequate ventilation.
- 3. If swallowed give water to dilute. Do not induce vomiting.
