



DESIGN IN COLOUR

All houses by John Scott are unique, but they share a common colour scheme.

When Kate Galloway and David Ramonteu bought their 1985 home designed by John Scott, the first thing they did was restore the paint scheme.

Where it was once beige, concrete-block walls are painted in crisp, almost chalky Resene Alabaster, while Resene Guardsman Red features on doors and under the eaves. Elsewhere, Resene Bokara Grey features in the 'winter lounge' and Resene Pitch Black picks out the beams above the living area. It's a crisp, subtle approach - we think Scott would have approved.
