• 1 piece of 600mm x 600mm plywood, 9mm thick

- Jig saw
- Power drill
- Drilling kit
- Sander or sandpaper in wood block, in medium and fine
- Wood glue
- Resene testpot brushes
- Resene Quick Dry waterborne primer undercoat
- Resene testpots in Resene Kumutoto and Resene Kaitoke Green
- Painter's tape
- Resene Aquaclear
- 20mm wood screws
- Filler Eezee Wood Patch Pine
- Putty knife (optional)
- Picture hanging strips
- Measuring tape, pencil, ruler and level

Entry organiser you'll need:

- 1 piece of 600mm x 600mm plywood, 9mm thick
- Templates of wavy tops for baseboard and mail holder (optional)
- 1 x piece of 16mm plywood dowel, at least 160mm in length
- 1 x piece of 12mm plywood dowel, at least 120mm in length
- Birch round elastic cord, at least 50mm in length
- Jig saw
- Power drill
- Drilling kit
- Sander or sandpaper in wood block, in medium and fine
- Wood glue
- Resene testpot brushes
- Resene Colorwood Rising Tide and Resene Colorwood Breathe Easy
- Resene Aquaclear
- 20mm wood screws
- Picture hanging strips
- Measuring tape, pencil, ruler and level
