Resene kids art with Mark Rayner – 3

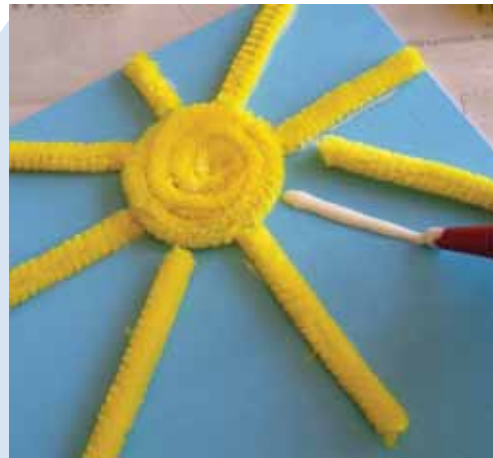
### You will need:

- Coloured pipe cleaners in the following colours: yellow, green, orange and purple
- Paintbrush
- Pre-primed canvas board
- PVA glue
- Resene Art Action tempera paint in the following colours: Resene Cool Blue, Resene Light Green and Resene White
- Safety scissors



#### Step one

Paint a grassy hill along the bottom of the canvas board using the Resene Light Green paint. Mix some Resene Cool Blue and Resene White paint to make a pale blue and paint in the sky. Leave to dry.



#### Step two

Roll a yellow pipe cleaner into a circle and stick onto the blue sky with PVA glue. Use the safety scissors to cut some shorter pieces for the sunrays and glue these into position.



#### Step three

Bend some green pipe cleaners to form a tree shape and glue it into position on the hill.



#### Step four

Make two 'stick' people from orange pipe cleaners and form a small circle from a purple pipe cleaner. Glue the 'stick' people and purple ball into position. Leave the picture flat until the glue is dry. Cool or what?



#### Top tip:

Coloured pipe cleaners are available from most craft or hobby shops.



#### Here's another idea:

A few purple pipe cleaners twisted together and two plastic craft eyes make for a fun furry spider.
