



Step 1

Open EzyPaint and click on Pictures (left sidebar, either Exterior or Interior).

Step 2 Select a picture, such as: Exterior, Residential Exteriors, 50's weatherboard.

A small version of the picture will show up.



Step 3

Click on Load Image (lower left sidebar). This will open a larger version of the image in the main EzyPaint screen.



Step 4

Go to ColorRite (top left sidebar) and select a chart, such as Resene BS2660 Range.

When you have selected a chart, click on Load in new and colour swatches for that chart will appear in the main screen.
