



## Design in colour

**A house on Waiheke Island by Bossley Architects fits beautifully into the landscape – but still has a bit of fun.**

On a large, covenanted property looking over the Hauraki Gulf sit two buildings by Bossley Architects – the first stages of what will be a complex of four. The landscape is important here: planted roofs hide the structures, and the main interior is deliberately painted a restful shade of Resene Rice Cake.

But this is Pete Bossley, so there has to be some colour. In the boatshed down the hill, close to the dinghies pulled up on Blackpool Beach, you'll find three doors painted in energetic shades of red, blue and yellow – Resene Bombshell, Resene Scooter and the wonderfully named Resene My Sin. A terrific combination, if ever there was one.
