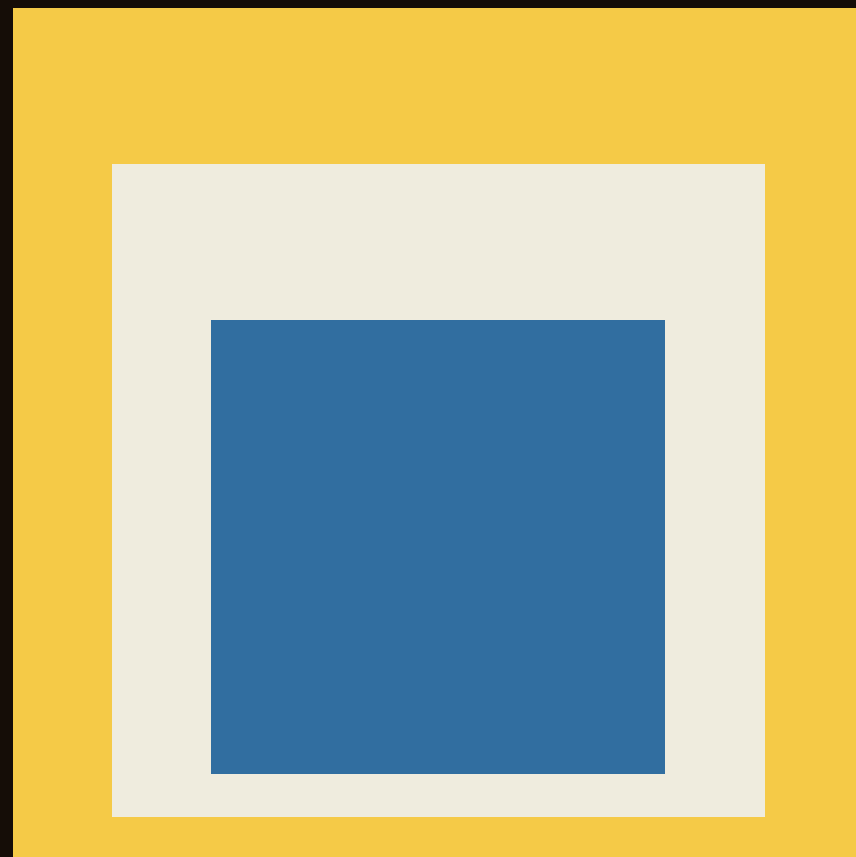


# WINNING COMBINATIONS

Winner, Urban Renewal

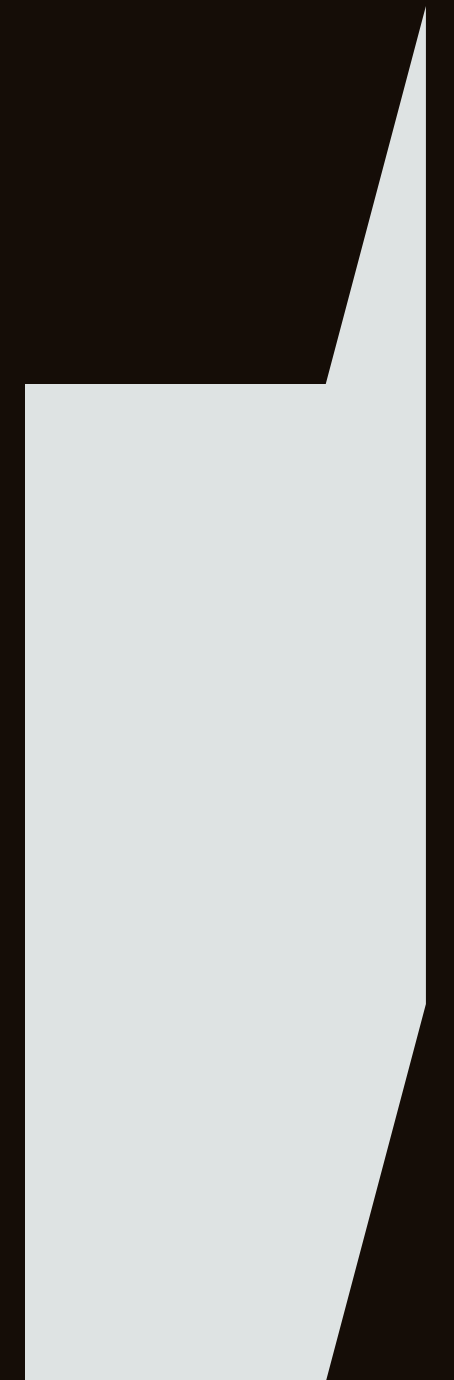
