

# Create your own colour scheme

## Roof

The roof is often not seen so choose a colour for its durability. Resene Summit Roof (satin) or Resene Hi-Glo (gloss) is ideal. See the Resene Roof systems colour chart for colour ideas. Consider using a Resene CoolColour to minimise heat buildup.



## Art Deco

### Walls

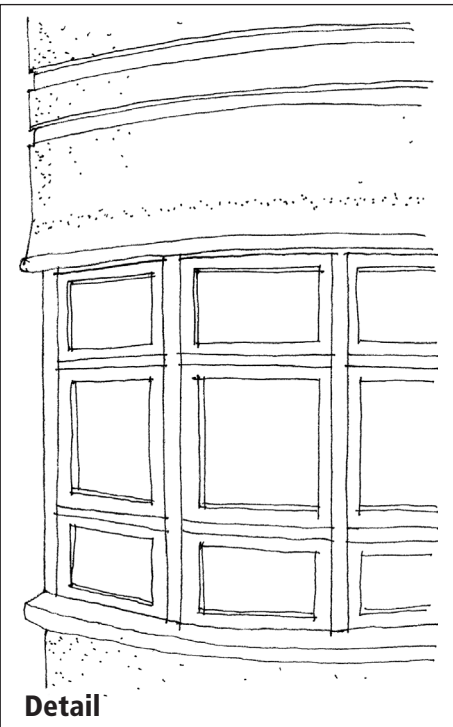
This style of house suits walls finished in white, light or pastel shades. Use Resene Hi-Glo (gloss), Resene Sonyx 101 (semi-gloss) or Resene Lumbersider (satin).

### Windows and doors

Windows look best in white or painted to match the walls. However, the addition of another colour may be a good idea to provide interest. Use Resene Enamacryl (gloss waterborne enamel) or Resene Lustacryl (semi-gloss waterborne enamel).

### Trim

Decorative features and windowsills may be painted in darker or brighter colours to provide contrast.
