Practical can be stylish, and Resene Blackboard Paint serves a multitude of purposes – from the drama of a black wall as a backdrop, to an ever-changing wall of chalk-penned art, to a wall of family organisation. While it works in any room, the hallway wall or back of the front door is the perfect position for a last minute reminder as family members exit the house.

These days chalkboard paint isn't limited to just black, but comes in a rainbow of hues, and by layering magnetic paint underneath you can take your board of lists to the next level. Scale is optional, from an entire wall, to a casually rolled section, or restrained inside a large frame.

Paint is such an easy way to inject colour and personality into any room, regardless of your own personal style, from a punchy full wall to a smaller art-sized piece, or even a colour blocked surprise on the inside of cupboard doors. Your options are endless.

Resene Ecstasy 

Cheap can be chic, in this case a handful of affordable Resene testpots really can go a long way. Draw your shapes on to the surface first, so you get your scale and positioning perfectly imperfect before you brandish your brush.

tip Stick to using just three accent colours for a wall treatment like this. More will make it look messy.

out of the box

When it looks this cool, a chalkboard will work anywhere; just roll the paint on in any direction to cover an area bigger than your frame. So easy!

tip Use hooks for keys or fix a small shallow box to the wall under the frame to store your chalk and duster.

 If you're painting shapes with straight edges onto a wall, like the grid overleaf, use Resene low-tack masking tape. It comes in a range of widths and will peel off without taking any paint with it. Make sure you remove the tape before the paint fully dries.
