



# Sense of theatre

Accent walls can make a strong visual statement in your home. Resene Volcano was chosen for this home theatre

The accent wall was painted in Resene SpaceCote Low Sheen, a tough, acrylic enamel, well suited to broadwall areas due to its durability and low sheen, which minimises surface imperfections.
