Petty Pink

MARK RAYNER turns an ordinary pot into a work of art.

You will need:

- Terracotta pot
- Resene Quick Dry Acrylic Primer Undercoat
- Resene testpots in Resene Pompadour, Resene
- Sassy, Resene Cabaret, Resene Shocking
- Resene Multishield+ gloss
- Terracotta sealer
- Masking tapePink cyclamen
- Potting mix



COAT the inside of the pot with terracotta sealer and the outside with one coat of Resene Quick Dry Acrylic Primer Undercoat. Allow to dry.



APPLY two coats of Resene Pompadour to the outside of the pot, allowing two hours between coats.



APPLY eight vertical equidistant strips of masking tape to the side of the pot. Apply a light coat of Resene Pompadour along the edge of the masking tape (this prevents colour bleeding). Allow to dry.



PAINT over the unmasked areas with two coats of Resene Sassy. Allow to dry.



APPLY another eight strips of masking tape, at equidistance, between the previous eight. Again, lightly paint along the edge of the masking tape with Resene Sassy.



PAINT over the unmasked areas with alternating coats of Resene Cabaret and Resene Shocking. Allow to dry and repeat.



CAREFULLY remove all 16 strips of masking tape and touch up any imperfections. Dry overnight.



APPLY two coats of Resene Multishield+ gloss, allowing each coat to dry thoroughly. Plant up with potting mix and pink cyclamen.
