

Potted colour

Mark Rayner transforms a boring old pot into a floral masterpiece.

You will need:

- Terracotta pot
- Terracotta sealer
- Resene Quick Dry Acrylic Primer Undercoat
- Resene testpots in the following colours: Resene Mariner, Resene Grass Hopper,

Resene Corn Field, Resene English Holly, Resene Lightning

- Resene Multishield+ Gloss
- Paintbrushes
- Small Artist's brush

To get the look Mark planted up our daisy pot with the marguerite 'Summer Lustre'.



FOLLOWING the manufacturer's instructions, seal the inside of the terracotta pot using terracotta sealer. Allow to dry.



PRIME the outside, top edge and inner rim of the pot using Resene Quick Dry Acrylic Primer Undercoat. Allow to dry.



PAINT the outside, top edge and inner rim of the pot with two coats of Resene Mariner. Allow to dry.



USING the artist's brush, paint daisy stems and leaves with Resene Grass Hopper. Allow to dry.



USING the artist's brush, paint daisy petals with Resene Corn Field. Allow to dry.



USING the artist's brush, paint blades of grass along the bottom edge of the pot with Resene English Holly. Allow



USING the artist's brush, paint the "eye" of each daisy with Resene Lightning Yellow. Allow to dry.



PAINT the outside, top edge and inner rim of the pot with two coats of Resene Multishield+ Gloss. Allow to dry.
