### You will need:

- Bucket
- Garden hose with clean running water
- Paintbrush
- Paint stirrer
- Resene Moss & Mould Killer
- Resene Timber and Deck Wash
- Resene Waterborne Woodsman tinted to Resene Evergreen
- Rubber gloves
- Stiff-bristled brush
- Wooden fence



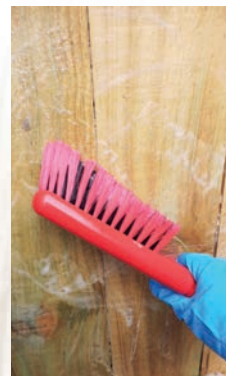
**Step one**  
Mix one part Resene Moss & Mould Killer to five parts clean water.



**Step two**  
Wearing rubber gloves, saturate and scrub the solution into the fence with a stiff-bristled brush and leave for 48 hours.



**Step three**  
Mix one part Resene Timber and Deck Wash to three parts clean water.



**Step four**  
Scrub the fence thoroughly with the solution using a stiff-bristled brush.



**Step five**  
Rinse well with clean water and allow the fence to dry.



**Step six**  
Carefully stir the Resene Waterborne Woodsman.



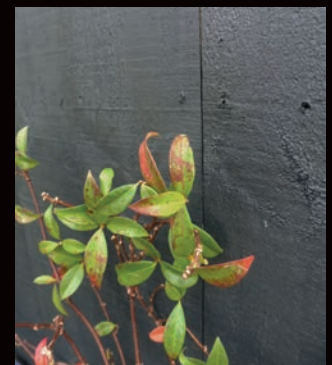
**Step seven**  
Apply one coat of Resene Waterborne Woodsman to the fence, brushing in the direction of the grain, and allow to dry.



**Step eight**  
Apply a second coat of Resene Waterborne Woodsman to the fence, brushing in the direction of the grain, and allow to dry.



**To get the look:**  
Mark stained the wooden raised bed with Resene Waterborne Woodsman tinted to Resene Skywater.



**Other ideas:**  
For a bright red effect, stain the fence with Resene Waterborne Woodsman tinted to Resene Totem Pole.
